

Some Things to Know When Visiting the Library:

Borrowing and Returns:

- Curbside pick-up is still available if you prefer not to enter the library. Request your materials in advance either by placing holds online or calling the library. If you place a hold on an item, please wait for notification from us that your item is available for pick-up before arranging pickup.
- All materials returned to the library are checked in, disinfected, and then quarantined for 72 hours before being returned to the shelves. Magazines are quarantined for 1 week.

Facilities:

- We would like to encourage patrons to do their best to limit their time in the library.
- Please do not enter the building if you are feeling unwell. Staff may ask you to leave the building if you are exhibiting signs of illness.
- Please practice social distancing while in the library.
- Children are welcome, but please keep ages 8 and under at arm's length to keep them and others safe. Children walking beside you must have sanitized hands, and please try to limit the amount of items that are handled. Thank you for understanding that these are difficult times, and we all must do our part.
- Tables and chairs are not available at this time.
- You are required to use hand sanitizer before entering.

Computers and Photocopying:

- Computers are available to the public.
- Time on computers will be limited to one 30-minute session per person per day. Keyboards etc. will be disinfected between uses.
- WiFi remains accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and the password is posted in the window.
- Laminating, photocopying, and scanning services are still available.

Staff:

- Front desk is equipped with plexiglass barriers to safely separate staff and patrons.
- Staff and patrons will wear face coverings if social distancing practices cannot be maintained.
