

Re-opening with care

Here is what to expect when you visit the library today:

Borrowing and Returns:

- Curb-side pick-up is still available if you prefer to not enter the library. Request your materials in advance either by placing holds online or calling the library. If you place a hold on an item, please wait for notification from us that your item is available for pick-up before coming in.
- All materials returned to the library will be quarantined for 72 hours before being checked in. Please do not renew items if you have already dropped them off. No fines will accrue during the quarantine process as items will be checked in using the date received.

Facilities:

- We would like to encourage patrons to do their best to limit their time in the library.
- Please do not enter the building if you are feeling unwell. Staff may ask you to leave the building if you are exhibiting signs of illness.
- Please practice social distancing while in the library.
- Children 8 & under will not be allowed in the building without an adult and are asked to be kept at arm's length.
- Tables and chairs will not be available at this time.
- You will be required to use hand sanitizer before entering.
- Follow our Facebook for updated information.

Computers and Photocopying:

- Computers are available to the public.
- Time on computers will be limited to one 30-minute session per person per day. Keyboards etc. will be disinfected between uses.
- WiFi remains accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and the password is posted in the window.
- Laminating, photocopying, and scanning services are still available.

Staff:

- Face coverings will be worn by staff and patrons if social distancing practices cannot be maintained.
- Front desk is equipped with plexiglass barriers to safely separate staff and patrons.
